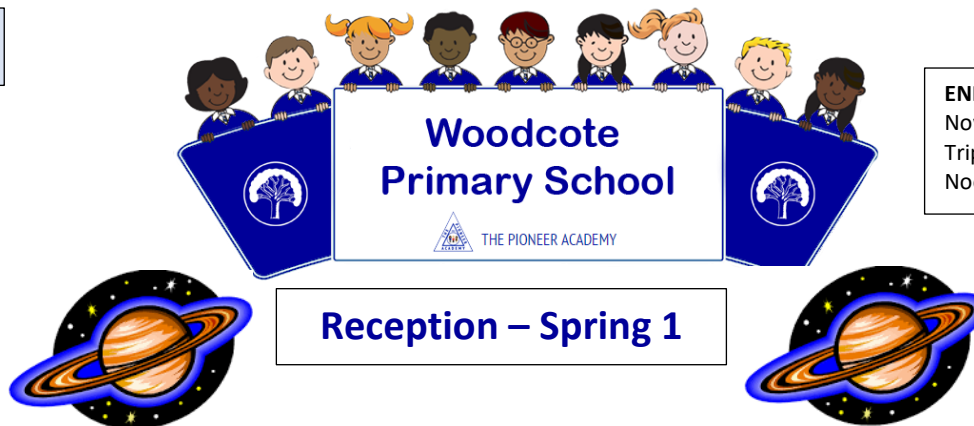


TOPIC – SPACE

- Identify Zones of regulation in themselves



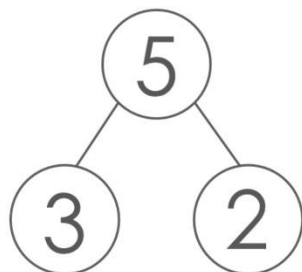

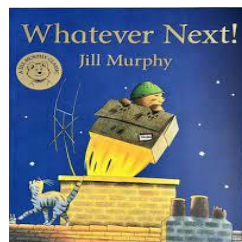
LITERACY

- Write some irregular common words



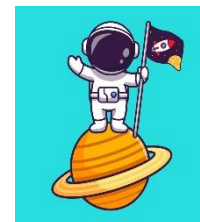
UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

- Ask questions to find out more
- Talk about features and photos of the local community
- Explore and talk about light and shadows – torches and objects
- Identify and explain features of images of the past, showing reasoning
- Explore and talk about the force of gravity – dropping objects onto flour
- Know life achievements of a significant person from the past
- Investigate things that glow in the dark

PHONICS

Reading and writing words and sentences with following diagraphs/trigraphs: ai, ee, igh, oa, oo (short), oo (long), ar, or air, er

Tricky words: was, you, they My, by, all, are, sure, pure

Communication and Language

- Ask questions relevant to theme – what do you know about space
- Talk about selected non-fiction, including new knowledge and vocabulary
- Retell a story from memory – Peace At Last
- Innovate a known story - Peace At Last
- Connect one idea or action to another using a range of connectives

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Can thread flexible string into a small hole – threading planets
- Cuts along a curved line – cutting out planets
- Chooses to move in a range of ways, freely and with confidence – moon walking
- Make changes to body shape, position and pace of movement
- Handles tools with increasing control and intention

EXPRESS ARTS AND DESIGN

- Explore materials to express ideas in 2D and 3D – junk model rockets, planets
- Paint with control and increasing complexity of detail
- Create different textures – textured planets
- Safely use and explore complex tools to attach and join
