World Environment Day – Wednesday 5th June

The Eco Committee are hosting a whole school assembly about World Environment Day which is coming up on Wednesday 5th June. They want the whole school to be thinking about climate change and the effect this is having on our planet.

This is a useful app to download, as you will not only be able to access your child's reports and data, but also see their attendance, update their details and also receive messages without cost to the school that text messages raise.

We ask that you download this app now, and not on the week of the 15th July, as the office will already be managing the massive task of uploading 880+ reports, attendance certificates and assessment information, and will not be able to help with any issues. Please note there could be a delay in sending Year 6 if we do not receive the data from the National Tests by this date.
