Communication

School Gates

Our school gates open at 8.30am and 3pm for drop off and pick up. Please wait for the gates to be opened by an attending member of staff or automatically. We ask that you do not buzz for the office and additionally we ask that you do not enter the school grounds before the gates are officially opened, as this is part of our safeguarding measures.





Woodcote Weekly Welcome

Each Monday, Mrs Baldock runs her Weekly Welcome Assembly for the whole school. We discuss different themes linked to our Six School Values, and have weekly focuses for the children and staff to work on.

This week we acknowledged National Poetry Day and the Chinese Mid-Autumn Festival. Our Eco Council shared the school Eco Code they had written, and our focus for the week was a reminder of the new responsibilities' children are taking part.

Next week we will be thinking about how we stay safe online, celebrating the Home Learning Projects many children completed over the Summer, and thinking about inclusion in terms of all the different languages spoken by the children in our school.

Headteacher Coffee Morning

Last year we tried a range of ways to gather parent voice and to give you information – some were more successful than others! On Thursday 17th October we will be holding a Headteacher Coffee Morning in the Staffroom at 8.45am.
