Home Reading

At Woodcote Primary School, we teach children to read through Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Phonics programme.

In school, your child has daily lessons, teaching them new sounds, letters that represent those sounds, and how to begin blending these to read. Reading at home plays a vital part in this too, as it provides opportunities for your child to practise their skills and develop fluency and a love of reading!

Little Wandle decodable phonics books

Your child will be bringing home a reading practice book matched to their phonic stage and will be fully decodable. Your child should be able to read the practice book independently and fluently without any significant help. Initially, your child may come home with a wordless book. To support your child with these, and all Little Wandle books, please read the highlighted grey section on the inside cover headed 'Reading at Home'.

You will notice your child brings home the same book throughout the week, this is because reading the same book will help to build their confidence and fluency, and will secure reading strategies. Once they can read the words in the book, they may wish to practise reading with expression. Your child will be familiar with this, as this is the approach we also use in school.

Your child will thrive on positive praise and encouragement as they show off their fabulous reading! (3)
