Individual and Sibling Photo Arrangements

We are doing individual school photographs on Monday 25th November and Tuesday 26th November. Please send your child in with their normal school uniform on those 2 days and not PE kit. As always, we have a loose plan for scheduling of the individual photos on Monday and Tuesday, this may be altered due to how quickly we go. WE will aim to start with Reception and Nursery on the Monday and work our way up the school.

If you would like a sibling photo (only for children who attend the school) then please arrive at school on one of the days between 8am-8.30am, preferably the Monday. Those that arrive at school first will be seen first and you may have to queue. All gates will be open. Please do not arrive after this time, as we will be stopping photographs at 8.45am.

For children mainly in Reception to year 2, please go to the Year 1/Year 2 playground to the staff room near the bottom of the tiered steps.

For children mainly in years 3 to year 6, please go to the middle playground and go to the library entrance near year 4.

If you are unsure, you can go to whichever is more convenient to get your children into registration on time.

Any parents who does not want sibling photo should NOT enter the school premises until 8.30am as per a normal school day.

Free School Meal/Pupil Premium Checker

Whilst we understand all children are receiving a free meal, or may not want a free meal, we ask that if you are in receipt of benefits that you check your child's eligibility using the link below. This not only provides additional funds for the school but can entitle you to supermarket or holiday club vouchers, uniform, or support with payment for trips and/or clubs for at least six years.
