# New Information

#### Parents Evening Reports

We are pleased to be able to share with parents in Years 1 to 6 new reports that will share your child's attainment from the Autumn Term and their current attendance percentage. These reports will be emailed to you on Monday from our new assessment system in preparation for your Parents' Evening Meetings next week. We hope this will give you information prior to the meeting and support discussions.

#### New Safety Measures – IMPORTANT PLEASE READ

We are continuing to put in place additional measures with regards to the safe entry and exit of your children throughout the extended school day. From Monday 13<sup>th</sup> January the new measures below will be in place.

- The gates at the top of the school drive are locked at 8.45am along with all other gates. Children are expected to be in class to start learning at 8.45am, so must be through the gates prior to this.
- All internal doors are locked from 9.15am, and throughout the day. This therefore means that office staff must go and collect or take children to classes during the school day, and this impacts on the working of the office. Please ensure children arrive punctually, and any movement from classes during the school day is exceptional.
- The front pedestrian gate only will be open from 3.00pm to 3.10pm for Nursery pick up. All other gates will remain closed, and parents for Key Stage 1 and 2 should wait until 3.10pm.
- All gates will now be open from 3.10pm 3.20pm, for collection from KS1 (3.15pm) and KS2 (3.20pm). This is 10 minutes later, enabling the site to remain securer for longer, and outdoor learning to continue until 3.10pm.
- Gates are locked again at 3.30pm to secure the site. Children who are attending Extra Curricular Clubs are collected from clubs that finish at either 4.15pm or 4.30pm. This will now take place via the Inner Vehicle Gate and up the drive. This gate will open automatically at 4.10pm until 4.40pm. The gates will then be closed again. The Lower Key Stage 2 area will not be open for access between 3.30pm 4.10pm. Please do not exit through the main car park gates but use the pedestrian exit next to Nursery.
- Staff will only release to an adult on the Home Time permissions list. If you have a change of collection for a oneoff event, the office must be emailed and not pass the message to the class teacher.
- Children in Years 1 to 6 are released in register order to parents, in order of the home time permissions list. From Monday 13<sup>th</sup> January Reception Classes will also be released in register/alphabetical order.

#### Maths Fluency Parent Workshop - Wednesday 22nd January

Mrs Moran (Maths Lead) will be offering a parent workshop from 2:45pm to 3:15pm in the staffroom focusing on fluency in Maths, including times tables. Having competent fluency skills is vital, as it enables children to grasp more complex concepts. One area of fluency is times tables and, as you know, all children are tested on the times tables (up to 12x12) at the end of Year 4. This session will discuss times tables teaching, progress of key fluency skills and strategies to support your child at home.

#### **NHS Pharmacy First Service**

Did you know that the NHS Pharmacy First Service enables children and adults to get convenient access to healthcare advice and treatment where appropriate, for seven common conditions without the potential delay of having to wait for a GP appointment? Accessing the service may mean that can help children feel better and back to school as quickly as possible, as well as supporting parents/carers to also get better if they are unwell with one of the conditions covered under the service. There is no need to make an appointment; parents or carers can pop into their local Boots pharmacy with their child and ask for help under the service.

Support for the following conditions can be accessed under the service, free of charge (unless NHS prescription charges apply):

Common condition	Patient eligibility
Earache	1 to 17 years
Impetigo	1 year and over
Infected insect bites and stings	1 year and over
Sore throats	5 years and over
Sinusitis	12 years and over
Uncomplicated urinary tract	Women 16 to 64 years
Shingles	18 years and over
