Knowing the importance for children to engage in physical and social activity, and play daily, we are keeping children out at break and lunchtimes in wet and cold weather, as long as it is safe. Please ensure your children come to school with appropriate clothing for the weather, such as a warm/waterproof coat and shoes.

Supporting our Amazing Office Team!

As you will know if you have ever called or visited the school office it is a busy hub of activity, and the heart of the school. The team in there oversee several important roles, and support us all in keeping the children, and adults on our school site safe. To support this team in being amazing please ensure you follow and understand the following;

- The office opening hours are 8.30am 3.45pm
- Most information you need can be found on our school website (<u>www.woodcoteprimary.croydon.sch.uk</u>) or on Weekly Memo's such as this.
- If you have a meeting with a member of staff before or after school you must enter and exit through the school office, and the member of staff you are meeting will escort you.
- Medicines, such as antibiotics, will only be administered by the office if it is required 4 times per day.

As part of our site security, we have our external doors shut, and several internal doors are also shut to segregate areas of the school. This means that for children to move between parts of the school they must be escorted. This can have a significant impact on the office staff who must take/collect. Please help by;

- Ensure your child arrives to school on time
- If you need to collect your child during the day for an appointment, you must inform the office in advance. You should prepare that it will take time for your child to be collected and brought to the office for you.
- Children will not be released to parents from the office after 3pm. You will need to wait until your child is dismissed from class.
- If you need to bring a forgotten item to the office to be given to your child, it will be taken at break or lunchtime only, and not during learning time.
