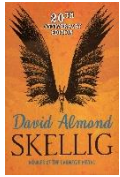

Piece 3: Exploitation - I understand that some people can be exploited and made to do things that are against the law

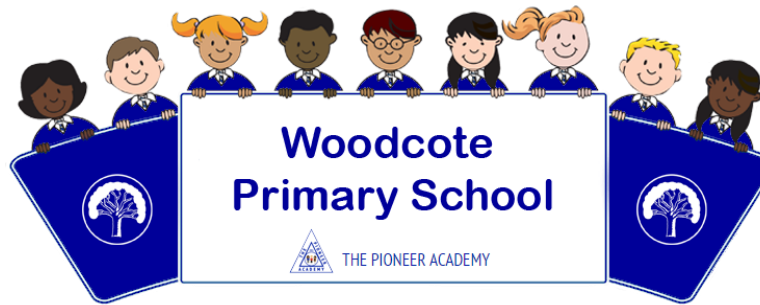
Piece 4: Gangs - I know why some people join gangs and the risks this involves
